## GLOBAL SAR PLAN CONTAINING INFORMATION ON THE CURRENT AVAILABILITY OF SAR SERVICES

### Introduction

1 This circular contains information on current availability of Search and Rescue (SAR) Services based on responses received from the Member Governments in line with COMSAR/Circ.27, as given in annex 1.

2 Data received by the Member Government according to the format for new combined SAR.2 and SAR.3 circulars is given in annex 2 and information on Telemedical Maritime Advice Services (TMAS) is given in annex 3.

3 Governments are invited to check the information contained in this circular and inform the Secretariat of any desired amendments thereto so that they can be included in the next edition of the Global SAR Plan. This circular is issued in loose-leaf format, updated twice a year and available at IMO website.

4 Governments, who have not yet responded to the COMSAR/Circ.27, are invited to do so as soon as possible.
